

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING UPON

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the 2018 Preliminary Budget for the Town of New Hartford, Oneida County, NY, has been completed and filed in the Office of the Town Clerk, 48 Genesee Street, New Hartford, NY, where it is available for inspection by any interested person during business hours (8:00 A.M. through 4:00 P.M., weekdays), or by visiting www.newhartfordtown.com. **PURSUANT** to Section 108 of Town Law, the proposed maximum salaries of the following Town Officials are hereby specified as follows:

Superintendent of Highways, including Sewer Superintendent	\$65,000
Chief Justice	\$21,304
Town Justice	\$18,504

FURTHER NOTICE is given that the New Hartford Town Board will meet and review said Preliminary Budget and hold a Public Hearing thereon in **Butler Memorial Hall (Ground Floor)**, 48 Genesee Street, New Hartford, NY, at **6:00 P.M. on Wednesday, November 8, 2017**, and that at such Hearing any person may be heard in favor of or in opposition to the Preliminary Budget as compiled, or for or against any item or items therein contained. Pursuant to Section 202-a and Section 239 of Town Law, the Town Board will hear and consider any objections which may be made to the special assessment rolls, and to consider the adoption of such special assessment rolls for the following districts:

- New Hartford Consolidated Sewer District (1 and 2)
- Clinton Street Sewer District
- Woodberry Hills Sewer District
- Higby Road Water District
- Water Fund (Consolidated)

The Town Board will also consider the following matters:

- The establishment of the ad valorem charges for Fire Protection Districts No. 1 through No. 5, inclusive, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2018
- The establishment of the ad valorem charges and/or unit charges for the various Street Lighting Districts for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2018
