

NOTICE OF WILDLIFE POPULATION MANAGEMENT PROJECT

Please advise all employees that may take wildlife calls that the United States Department of Agriculture, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, Wildlife Services program will be applying the registered restricted use pesticide DRC-1339 (see attached Tech Note) to reduce disease threats to livestock and reduce livestock feed consumption associated with European starlings at dairy farms. Applications will occur in January and February at farms located in your county. The birds will succumb to the pesticide within 24 hours after the application of DRC-1339. Birds may expire away from the treatment site; they are **NOT** hazardous to handle. Birds may be picked up and disposed of in the garbage. If pets happen to come in contact with or eat any of these birds, there is no need for concern. If necessary, arrangements can be made to pick up large numbers of birds.
